

### The 2007 Season Set To Start With A Bang

I he 2007 season is about to get underway, so spread the word to anyone you know that has not registered yet.

An important feature of the early part of the season will be not One but Two double header weekends to ensure that this year gets off with a bang. You will also note that the venues on offer are about as varied as you can get.

As in 2006, the opening rounds (17/18 March) will start with the "Bathurst Weekend" which BLCC has become very experienced in staging. These two courses reward real power and speed, not to mention a large dollop of commitment.

Saturday kicks it all off at the challenging

Esses, followed by the lengthy Mountain Straight climb on Sunday. (At over 1Km in length, it is certainly one to savour).

Get that entry in early, as Bathurst really is Oz motorsport headquarters and always popular.

The following month sees an exciting new innovation. For the first time, two clubs are linking up to provide a double header at Canberra and Goulburn on the weekend of 28/29 April.

The Manly/Warringah Sporting and Southern Districts Motorsport clubs have thrown their combined support behind a challenge that is guaranteed to interest the keen hillclimber.

Saturday will feature the tight but challenging turns of Fairbairn Park, while Sunday will run on twisting course at Wakefield Park. This provides contrast to the opening rounds as the Southern courses reward the more nimble performer, emphasising handling rather than raw power.

So, if you like your motorsport with spice and variety, not found elsewhere, don't miss these opening rounds.




